The “New Dynamics” in North East Asia: Security and Political Relations

Every major North East Asian country, including the U.S. as a Pacific nation, is undergoing major political transition now and in the coming year. Thus domestic politics inhibit diplomatic initiatives that reach out to the concerns of others. Chris Nelson will discuss the domestic and international implications for the major states in the region, with attention to U.S. policy.

Chris Nelson is a Senior Vice President at Samuels International and editor of *The Nelson Report*, a remarkably influential daily briefing on international economic policy issues, foreign and security policy matters and their relationship to politics in Washington. His previous experience is as a journalist and Capitol Hill foreign affairs analyst. He served on the House Foreign Affairs Subcommittee on Asia and as a Senior Advisor to Senate Majority Leader Byrd. He has degrees from the University of California, Berkeley and McGill University, Montreal.
